The seminar ministry also includes teaching students in Bible Schools and Colleges. A range of devotional publications and teaching aids are available at seminars and by mail order.

In 1996 our children's programme, which is now called Bible Explorer, was launched as part of Walk Through to teach the story line of the Bible exclusively in Junior and Middle schools to children of school years 5 & 6 (ages 9 to 11 years). The Old and New Testament are each taught in five one-hour sessions.
