| 1 | Creation | Gen 1-2 | God creates the whole universe |
| | Fall | Gen 3 | Man and woman mess it up! |
| | Flood | Gen 6-9 | God washes the world clean and starts again with Noah |
| | Nations | Gen 10-11 | God changes languages - so they spread out into nations |
| 2 | Abraham | Gen 12-25 | God promises to bless him with many children |
| | Isaac | Gen 25-26 | Abraham and Sarah laugh when they hear about Isaac |
| | Jacob | Gen 27-36 | Jacob wrestles with Esau and God for blessings |
| | Joseph | Gen 37-50 | As Dad's favourite Joseph receives a coat of many colours |
| 3 | Moses | Exo 1-6 | Moses leads God's people out of Egypt |
| | Passover | Exo 12 | God shows His power over gods, then sets His people free |
| | Law | Exo 20-24 | God provides a way for His people to live well |
| | Tabernacle | Exo 25-40 | They put the Law in an Ark, 'God's Tent', in His presence |
| 4 | Offerings - Feasts | Lev 1-27 | God requires His people to say sorry and give thanks |
| | Counting - Spying | Num 1, 13 | They check out the Promised Land |
| | Wandering - Dying | Num 14-33 | They decide it is too difficult a task, so quit |
| | Second Law | Deut 1-30 | The Commandments are given again by Moses |
| 5 | Joshua | Jos 1-6 | The military leader takes over from Moses |
| | Divide - Conquer | Jos 6-11 | They all enter the Promised Land |
| | 12 Tribes | Jos 13-21 | The land is divided into 12 sections for the tribes of Israel |
| | Judges | Judg 1-21 | The people go through the same Cycle 7 times |
| 6 | Deborah | Judg 4-5 | Only female Judge |
| | Gideon | Judg 6-8 | Gideon tests God's plan, but then trusts |
| | Samson | Judg 13-16 | Lots of mistakes from a strong but foolish Samson |
| | Loving Ruth | Ruth 1-4 | Ruth shows love to Naomi, then later to Boaz |
| 7 | Samuel | 1 Sam 1-25 | Samuel hears the voice of God |
| | United Kingdom | 1 Sam 9 - 1 Kgs 11 | All 12 tribes unite - "We want a king!" |
| | Saul - No Heart | 1 Sam 9 - 2 Sam 1 | The 1st King has no heart for God |
| | David - Whole Heart | 2 Sam 2 - 1 Kgs 2 | The 2nd King has a whole heart for God but makes mistakes |
| 8 | Solomon - Half Heart | 1 Kgs 1-11 | The 3rd King has a great wise start, but a poor finish |
| | Divided Kingdom | 1 Kgs 12 - 2 Kgs 25 | Solomon's son has a manifesto that splits the kingdom |
| | Mostly Bad Kings | 1 Kgs 12 - 2 Kgs 25 | Only 8 out of 39 were Godly kings, 31 were Bad |
| | Prophets Speak | 1 Kgs 17-18 | Elijah, and others, begin to pass on God's warnings |
| 9 | Israel Scattered | 2 Kgs 17-18 | The Assyrians attack and scatter the 10 tribes of Israel |
| | Judah Exiled | 2 Kgs 25 | The Babylonians attack Judah - beginning a 70 year exile |
| | Judah Returned | 2 Chron 36, Ezra 1 | The Persians return the people to Judah |
| | Zerubbabel Temple | Ezra 1-6 | Zerubbabel returns to rebuild the Temple |
| 10 | Esther Queen | Esther 1-9 | The Jewish Queen of Persia saves God's people |
| | Ezra People | Ezra 7-10 | Ezra returns, teaching the people how to worship God |
| | Nehemiah Walls | Neh 1-6 | Nehemiah returns to rebuild Jerusalem's walls |
| | Wait... Christ | | Messiah will come, but God doesn't send him for 400 years |
