1	Creation Fall Flood Nations	To introduce the structure and literature of the Bible. To consider the first four major events in Genesis 1-11.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? Can you think of 5 words to describe Noah?
2	Abraham Isaac Jacob Joseph	To examine the geographical context. To consider the storyline of the patriarchs from Genesis 11-50.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? Can you compose 3 questions that we could ask Joseph?
3	Moses Passover Law Tabernacle	To explore the significant elements of the first 80 years in the life of Moses from the book of Exodus.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? If you could add one law to the ten commandments, what would it be?
4	Offerings Feasts Counting Spying Wandering Dying Second Law	To explore the significant elements of the final 40 years in the life of Moses from the books of Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? What would you say was the most memorable event in Moses life?
5	Joshua Divide Conquer 12 Tribes Judges	To describe the storyline of the book of Joshua and the ultimate need for Judges, as the people of Israel finally enter the Promised Land.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? We've seen Moses and Joshua lead the people. What do you think makes a great leader?
6	Deborah Gideon Samson Loving Ruth	To explore the three most prominent Biblical Judges; Deborah, Gideon and Samson - plus Ruth, whose story is also found in the time of the Judges.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? Ruth was a good friend to Naomi. What would you say were the five most important attributes that make a great friend?
7	Samuel United Kingdom Saul No Heart David Whole Heart	To consider the rule of the Kings as the 12 tribes of Israel unite, through the two books of Samuel.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? Can you compose a poem based on God seeing the 'heart' not just the outward appearance?
8	Solomon Half Heart Divided Kingdom Mostly Bad Kings Prophets Speak	To consider the divide in the Kingdom after the reign of Solomon, through the book of 1 Kings.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? What do you understand from 'these words' from a Prophet? (Maybe consider Micah 6:8, Joel 2:12-13 or Isaiah 40:31)
9	Israel Scattered Judah Exiled Judah Returned Zerubbabel Temple	To identify key elements, including the geography, of the latter stages of the Old Testament through the book of 2 Kings.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? Can you compose a newspaper headline or freeze frame that summarises one of the stories from the Old Testament?
10	Esther Queen Ezra People Nehemiah Walls Wait... Christ	To examine two further returns from Babylonian exile, after Zerubbabel. To introduce the geographical context. To set the scene for the promised Christ.	Can you summarise today's four stories in four sentences? What was your favourite story from the Old Testament - and why?
