	Lesson Objectives	Key Content	Success Criteria
<b>Lesson 1</b> <i>Arrival - Who is Jesus?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To introduce the life of Christ.</li> <li>To describe the relevant geography and world history of the Old and New Testaments.</li> </ul>	Birth and childhood of Jesus, His baptism and early ministry.	Pupils can recall the key elements of Jesus arrival. Using their knowledge of the values espoused by Jesus, pupils can argue the importance of a chosen profession.
<b>Lesson 2</b> <i>Ministry - What did Jesus do?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To examine the life of Christ and His ministry.</li> </ul>	Selection of the disciples; Sermon on the Mount; key miracles and parables; Peter's testimony; Jesus' transfiguration.	Pupils can recall the key elements of the ministry of Jesus. Pupils can debate the options open to Zacchaeus - Rich/Unliked vs Poor/Liked.
<b>Lesson 3</b> <i>Passion - Why did Jesus die?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To tell the storyline of the Gospels relating to the last weeks of Jesus' life.</li> </ul>	Teaching in Perea; Stories in Judea; Palm Sunday; temple cleansing; last supper; Jesus' trials, crucifixion, resurrection and ascension.	Pupils can recall the key elements of Jesus final week on earth. Pupils can compose 3 questions that could be asked of Jesus. Pupils can compose a poem based on the characteristics of Jesus.
<b>Lesson 4</b> <i>Church - When did Jesus' church begin?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To examine the first Christian church and its early leaders.</li> </ul>	The beginning of the early Church, choosing of the apostles and Pentecost. Apostle Paul's conversion.	Pupils can recall the key elements in the story of the early church. Pupils can choose 5 words to highlight aspects of what a community should do. Pupils can describe one thing that they've been so passionate about that they couldn't wait to tell people.
<b>Lesson 5</b> <i>Expansion - Where did Jesus' message go?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To discuss the missionary journeys and writings of Paul.</li> </ul>	Paul's missionary journeys, trials and imprisonment. The expansion of Christianity	Pupils can recall the key elements in the expansion of the Gospel. Pupils can compose a newspaper headline or freeze frame that summarises one of the stories covered in the five NT MINI lessons.
